THE NIGHT PORTER THE RISE AND SCANDAL OF A LEGENDARY FILM

Italy, France | 2025 | 52 min | color

Directed by Adolfo Conti

Plot summary 2023, Venice International Film Festival. Liliana Cavani is awarded with the Golden Lion for Lifetime Achievement. She is the first female director to receive this prestigious prize. Charlotte Rampling introduces it with these words: "Liliana and I have been defined by the Night Porter. Our work in film has been defined by the Night Porter".

The Night Porter tells a shocking story: the passionate and tragic relationship between an executioner, an SS officer, and his victim, a prisoner in a concentration camp. Is it possible that good and evil touch and coexist in us to this extent? When the film was released in Paris in April 1974, it divided critics and audiences. And the same thing happened in London, New York, Vienna, Berlin... Everywhere intellectuals, critics and public fueled a heated debate on what has been defined the most controversial film of the XX Century. In Italy it was blocked for months by censorship and the judiciary: the world of cinema reacted by stopping filming on movie sets. Eventually the film was also released in Italian theaters. Since then the bonfire of "The Night Porter" has continued to burn. To discover the reasons that led Liliana Cavani to tackle such a wrenching theme, the director herself will tell the story of the film's production through funny, dramatic and touching episodes. Charlotte Rampling will recall her experience as the lead actress. Both Cavani and Rampling will talk about the fundamental themes of the film: the relationship between victim and executioner, memory and oblivion, sense of guilty and passion.



ALL THE THINGS THAT REMAIN

Plot summary In a secluded corner of Cinecittà there is a magic place virtually no one knows which is bound to disappear soon enough. STUDIO E.L. founded in 1983 by Ettore Scola and Luciano Riccieri, is a creative space, a renaissance laboratory, a factory. A place where the two close friends worked on their movies for Cinecittà, but also a place where so many young artists were given the opportunity to grow and improve in their professional careers. After Ettore Scola's and Luciano Ricceri's demise, time has stopped at Studio E.L. and so has the life of so many items that represent the memory of almost 40 years' history of our cinema. Before closing down Studio E.L. forever, before turning it into a museum space, we would like to recognize the value of the items that can be found there and to reveal their story. Those items will be the fil rouge of the story, they will help reawaken the memories of the people that regularly attended Studio E.L.. Those items will help us to rediscover Ettore Scola filmmaking through the stories revealed by loyal artisans.

CONTROLUCE Italy | 2024 | color **Directed by** Tony Saccucci **Plot summary** The protagonist of "Contro Luce" is Adolfo Porry-Pastorel, photographer, journalist, father of Italian photojournalists, progenitor of the 'paparazzi'. Born in 1888, pioneer of a new language, ingenious creator of advertising gimmicks, founder at just 20 years old of the agency V.E.D.O. - Visioni Editoriali Diffuse Ovunque, able to be with his camera in the right place at the right time before his competitors, author of sensational scoops, in the 1910s Porry is already a number one in news and current affairs photography. Between the two wars he manages to pass thanks to his talent and ubiquity for "Mussolini's photographe" and simultaneously for an annoying scrutinizer of the regime (the exchange of jokes between the two is very famous: "Always the usual photographer" - "Always the usual Prime Minister"). He has access to the most intimate rooms of the head of the regime and is closely watched by the fascist censors. Millions of readers, thanks to his photos, have the living chronicle of major historical and political events (first of all Mussolini's arrest in 1915, the March on Rome, the discovery of Giacomo Matteotti's body), customs, leisure time, the new habits of Italians. **Festival highlights** Turin Film Festival 2024

THE STRESSFUL ART OF LIVING

Plot summary The documentary begins at the end: the weekend of 26/27 August 1950, the last, hectic days of Pavese's life. He wanders around the deserted city, looking for friends he cannot find, writing, telephoning people. On the Sunday evening, in a hotel near the station in Turin, he takes his own life. This epilogue provides the premise to recount another story. The story of a man, a writer and an intellectual who in his short life managed to invent, and above all create, a new literary and cultural world that would mark the second half of the 20th century in Italy and give it an identity.

All this, brought to life through a selection of archive material, numerous interviews and, above all, visual and musical atmospheres recreated in traditionally "Pavesian" locations that provide a fantastical backdrop to his texts, letters, poems and diaries.
